## RESUME

### Plays

**Life Don't Give You No Do Overs** raises the issue and *conflict* of organ donation that a family experiences in a hospital waiting room as a result of a fatal injury to their 17 year old son.

**Candy Apples** a play in two acts about three sisters deciding who should care for their aging mother suffering from Alzheimer's. The least likely of the three is chosen.

**White-Collar Crime** a play in two acts dealing with priests' dissension within the Catholic Church and extreme measures used by the hierarchy to quell any disagreement.

**At Heaven's Door** a farce in two acts which takes place in a waiting area just outside Heaven's Door while one's life is being reviewed. 3 actors play 21 roles.

**Yola's 90<sup>th</sup> Birthday Party** is a murderously funny play where two elderly sisters aged 90 and 83 deal with a conniving maintenance man preying on residents of their senior citizen apartment complex.

**4 Chairs** features 4 plays (in two acts), played by 4 actors with a set comprised of 4 chairs. One play is about a cause-oriented, older couple attempting to convince their son that he is gay. Another play hilariously presents a case of mistaken identity (confusing a microbiologist with a hit man...and vice versa). Three unemployed neighbors form a floral delivery service in this madcap adventure with an inebriated receptionist sending them on deliveries. The last play deals with life's final ride.
